

## VCCF Scholarship Guidelines 2022-2023

In addition to other terms/conditions, the number and amount of all VCCF scholarship awards is contingent on availability of funding. Scholarship awards are for the Fall 2023 – Summer 2024 Term and recipients must be enrolled during these terms to receive the awards.

• Apply-To: After applicants have completed the general application and pressed "finish and submit", they MUST click on "other opportunities" and apply-to specific scholarship opportunites. Please carefully review the guidelines to determine which scholarship opportunities you qualify for.

•Auto-Match: (new this year) Applicants will be automatically matched to specific scholarship opportunities that they qualify for based on the answers provided in the general application.
