



VCCF Scholarship Guidelines 2024-25

In addition to other terms/conditions, the number and amount of all VCCF scholarship awards is contingent on availability of funding. Scholarship awards are for the Fall 2025 – Summer 2026 terms and recipients must be enrolled during these terms to receive the awards.

• **Apply-To:** After applicants have completed the general application and pressed “finish and submit”, they MUST click on “other opportunities” and **apply-to** specific scholarship opportunities. Please carefully review the guidelines to determine which scholarship opportunities you qualify for.

• **Auto-Match:** Applicants will be automatically matched to specific scholarship opportunities that they qualify for based on the answers provided in the general application.

Applicants must have a minimum 2.7 unweighted GPA and demonstrate financial need. Applicant must be a first-generation college student and be bilingual.</p> <p>Required Essay: In 300-500 words please explain your interests and experiences and how bilingualism has impacted your life.</p>

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA. Applicant's school and community activities must demonstrate the applicant's commitment to both goals of safe schools and encouraging good citizenship. Letters of recommendations should address the applicant's commitment to safe schools and encouragement of good citizenship.</p> <p>Required Essay: In 1000 words or less, please tell us how you contribute to promoting safe schools and how you encourage good citizenship.</p>
John and Agnes McFarlane Scholarship Fund	Varies: \$2500 for community college enrollees; \$5000 for 4-year college enrollees	Apply-To	<p>College Major/Area of Study: Degree or certification in an occupation related to a life of public service, including majors in healthcare, political science, journalism, education, and social services.</p> <p>Awarded to Ventura County residents who have graduated from or will graduate from any high school in Ventura County, and will enroll or are enrolled at a career or technical training institute, accredited community college, or a college/university in the state of California. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to applicants who show promise for a career in public service as evidenced by participation in school or community activities and information provided in the essay. A minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 is required. Applicants must demonstrate dedication to civic engagement, social initiatives, and/or community service. Preference will be given to single mothers who are working to obtain a marketable skill by attending vocational school or furthering their education.</p> <p>Required Essay: In 300 to 500 words, please tell us what you hope to accomplish when you complete your education. If you are a single mother, please tell us what motivates you to go to school?</p>

Ventura County Medical Education Fund	Varies	Apply-To	<p>Area of Study: Medical/Health Care Field</p> <p>This Fund was developed to create a pipeline of new medical professionals to serve in Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) or public hospitals in Ventura County. Awarded to applicants who are graduating or have graduated from a Ventura County high school and who will enroll or are currently enrolled in a program to pursue a Certification, Associates, Bachelor or Master's degree. Applicants must be committed to providing hands on health care delivery in a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) or public hospital in Ventura County. Applicants must have a minimum of 2.0 unweighted GPA.</p> <p>College Major/Certification: Certification, Associates, Bachelors, Masters, Doctorate in the following healthcare fields: Biology, chemistry, health science, physical therapy (all levels), occupational therapy, speech therapy, kinesiology, medical coding, cancer registrar, health management, pharmacy (all levels), phlebotomy, bio-chemistry, substance abuse certificate, social work, psychology, clinical lab scientist, Marriage and Family Therapy, Public Health or Nursing, Certified Nurse Assistant, EMT, paramedics, dentistry, operation room technician, scrub technician, sterile processing technician, respiratory therapy, imaging/radiology (all levels), front/back office medical assistant, Physician Assistant, registered dietician, medical lab technician, optometry/opticians (all levels).</p> <p>Special Requirements: This award is a "grant service obligation."
